## FAQs

### Are there any entry requirements?

There are no entry requirements, but we recommend candidates to have basic foundational knowledge in sustainability to maximise the benefits of this programme.

### How long will it take to complete the programme and receive the certificate?

The learning content is 30 hours in duration, and the recommended study hour is ~60 hours, including pre-readings, online learning, webinar(s), the assessment, and an optional in-person networking session.

### How do I receive the certificate?

You will have six months from registration to complete all course content then take the assessment. The assessment will be completed virtually with online proctors administered by CASI. Upon completing 100% of the mandatory course content and achieving over 75% in the assessment, you will receive a digital Certificate of Completion.
